
## Past, Present, Puzzled!



## **ACROSS**

- 1. NTUC was formed to advocate for fair **WAGES**.
- 2. After the Modernization Seminar, NTUC set up several co-<u>OPERATIVES</u> to provide workers with affordable services like insurance, groceries, and transport.
- 3. During Singapore's first recession, the tripartite Economic Committee recommended wage freezes and a reduction in <a href="#">CPF</a> contributions to protect jobs.
- 4. NTUC's membership programme for students and young workers is called **STARTER**.
- 5. This institute helps workers upgrade their skills and find better jobs.
- The 2025 law that protects delivery riders and private hire drivers is called the Platform WORKERS ACT.
