It was an invigorating sight to take in as students from primary to university, cheered on by their parents and the HSEU Family, gathered on 25 February 2023 at ITE College Central to receive the awards.

This year, the income criteria was enhanced so as to cast the net wider for more families to be eligible for the bursary awards. This time round, members with Gross Household Income (GHI) of \$3800, up from \$3500; and Per Capita Income (PCI) of \$950, up from \$860, were eligible to apply for the bursary award.

Not just that. The bursary quantum was also enhanced by \$50 to \$120 to better bless the recipients.



Held from 18 to 20 March 2023 in Kuching, Malaysia, the Seminar gathered some 120 HSEU Branch Officials to a Dialogue with HSEU top leaders in preparation for the branches Quadrennial General Meetings which will be held from April to June 2023.

The Dialogue at the Seminar was centred around a call to action for branch officials to review their existing branch committees, plan for leadership succession and work with management partners to identify potential branch officials.

The Dialogue also delved into the implementation of the framework for the prevention of abuse and harassment of healthcare workers, such as the escalation process when cases of abuse and harassment are reported at the various institutions.

Another salient discussion point was the need to review the patient satisfaction survey as it may have inadvertently created unrealistic expectations of staff service and quality, adding to the pressure already faced by healthcare workers.









All in all, it was a fruitful Dialogue for HSEU's branch officials as they gear up for the upcoming branches Quadrennial General Meetings. To our branch leaders who are stepping down to make way for new leaders, thank you for your years of service and commitment to all our members.
