NTUC-U Care Fund was started in 2009 to help NTUC union members affected by the economic downturn then. More than 10 years on, we remain committed to help our members through various challenges brought about by retrenchments and rising costs of living and today.

One such example is the NTUC Care Fund (Special Assistance) which was rolled out in August 2022. This one-off cash relief helped members to alleviate the rising cost of daily essentials. More than \$1 million has been disbursed, benefitting over 8,000 members.

With the support of our donors and like-minded partners, we will continue to help members and their families emerge stronger and thrive in the face of adversity.

# NTUC Care Fund (e-Vouchers)

The NTUC Care Fund (e-Vouchers) programme helps lower-income union members defray the cost of daily necessities and school essentials. **Close to \$2,000,000** was disbursed electronically to close to **10,000 members** and **over 9,000 children**.

# U Care Caring • Sharing • Reaching Out (U Care CSR) Grant

Close to \$30,000 went towards supporting some 16 community service projects that reached out to over 1,500 beneficiaries.

# U Care Education Co-Funding Scheme

The U Care Education Co-Funding Scheme aims to motivate members' school-going children through bursary awards. In 2022, more than \$340,000 was disbursed to some 3,960 children.

# CapitaLand-U Care Resilience and Enablement (CAP+Ure) Fund

The aim of CAP+Ure Fund is to provide interim support for members impacted by a total and sudden (unexpected) loss of income, to help support their children's daily necessities and schooling needs.

To date, some 354 members and 734 children have benefitted from this Fund.
