Sim Bee Lan joined National Parks Board (NParks) in 2002 as a Park Officer and has been a dedicated Union member and Branch Official since 2009. Her commitment to fostering inter-agency collaboration has led to effective partnerships across public agencies and organisations.

Sister Bee Lan is responsible for the operations of Hong Lim Park and Speakers' Corner, where she works closely with government agencies to facilitate seamless event management and timely communication. Her contributions extend to the Tanjong Pagar and Chinatown precincts, where she collaborates with the People's Association (PA), the Urban Redevelopment Authority (URA), and Discover Tanjong Pagar (DTP) to enhance community engagement. She played a key role in co-activating Tras Link Park with events such as the iLight 2024 installation, which contributed to the URA and DTP team receiving the Municipal Services Award in 2022 for the "Rejuvenation of Tanjong Pagar."

Her dedication has been recognised through career progression to the position of Senior Manager and multiple accolades, including the National Day Award's Efficiency Medal in 2016. She is also a four-time recipient of the NParks Divisional Star Award for service excellence.

Beyond her core responsibilities, Sister Bee Lan serves as her branch's system representative, acting as a crucial intermediary between staff users and system administrators for platforms such as MAVEN, Site Infinity, Isomer, VOICES, and APDES. She also plays an active role as her cluster's representative in the NParks Events Management Workgroup, guiding colleagues on Temporary Occupation Licence (TOL) fees, land usage, and event-related matters. Her efforts have been instrumental in streamlining processes, improving workflows, and ensuring that essential guidelines on TOL and events are readily accessible via NParks' intranet.
