First Company Training Committee (CTC) formed in the Security Industry

USE signed its first CTC with Certis Cisco with the intent to cover all 16,000 of its officers to increase security outcomes and productivity.

The first project will be a 50-men site covering the cross skilling of officers to include facility management and remote monitoring capabilities. This will help reduce the manpower to 30 officers, with gains to be shared equally with them.

What are some of the employment related cases we have helped our security officers with?

Non-payment of CPF by employers:

- 1. Besides the CPF contribution by employers, the employees' contribution to CPF was also not paid promptly and both contributions were delayed for as long as 6 months.
- 2. No CPF contributions were made for employee who resigned or was terminated in the middle of the month

Things to note:

- 1. Employers' CPF contributions are to be paid on wages received by employees as long as employees earn more than \$50 in a month.
- 2. Employees' CPF Contribution are payable for wages more than \$500 in a month.
- 3. For employees who joined the company or left employment in the middle of the month, CPF contributions are payable based on the pro-rated wages earned for the month.
- 4. Login to CPF website at www.cpf.gov.sg to check if your employer has made the contributions. Should there be a delay, contact USE immediately.
