

Updates on the Security Industry

There have been many exciting updates in the Security Industry over the past 6 months. Let us do a summary for you!

New Mandatory WSQ for Security Officers

WSQ Recognise Terrorist Threats

Covers the skills and knowledge required to be aware of terrorist risks and threats, identify suspicious activities through behavioural profiling, handle situations involving suspicious persons, objects, vehicles and powders and respond to bomb threats and provide the after-incident response.

D-Day: 1 Jan 2020

From 1 Jan 2020, security officers will be required to obtain a third basic licensing unit, known as "Recognise Terrorist Threats" (RTT).

MUST I TAKE RTT?

Those who do not complete RTT training by **1 Jan 2020** will still be able to retain their licences, but can only be deployed at warehouses and condominiums.

I AM "HANDLE COUNTER TERRORISM ACTIVITIES (HCTA)" - TRAINED, DO I NEED TO TAKE RTT?

Security Officers who have completed HCTA are deemed to have met the new RTT licensing requirement. However, HCTA-trained Security Officers are strongly encouraged to view the SGSecure videos on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation, Automated External Defibrillators and Improvised First Aid Skills.

Progressive Wage Model Review

On 23 November 2017, the Government has endorsed the Security Tripartite Cluster's (STC) calls to increase the Progressive Wage Model (PWM) wage floors from January 2019. In addition, the overtime exemption (OTE) for the sector will be removed from January 2021. With these changes, security officers can look forward to better pay and greater work-life balance in the coming years. All these efforts will play a role in transforming the industry.



What are the 3 things you need to know about the new PWM review?

1

From 1 January 2019 to 2021, there will be quantum increases to the PWM wage base floor. Higher increments are recommended in 2021 – the year that OTE is removed – so that most security officers' gross wages would not be affected due to the reduction in overtime hours.

For 2022 to 2024, there will be an increment of at least 3% per annum to the PWM basic wage across all ranks.


The Schedule of Increases would also reduce any wage reset for security officers when the contract is renewed or awarded to a different service provider.

When Overtime Exemption (OTE) is removed from 1 January 2021, officers cannot work more than 72 hours of overtime per month according to the Employment Act.

The Union ensured that gross wages will not be affected after this change. Officers can thus enjoy better work-life balance.


