At present, he is Chairman of Tangram Asia Capital (Tangram), the private markets investment arm established by NTUC Enterprise, and the founder and Managing Director of Sirius Venture Capital. He also sits on the board of several Singapore Exchange-listed companies and serves on the People's Association's Investment Advisory Committee.

Brother Eugene has demonstrated unwavering dedication to the Labour Movement, working tirelessly to enhance the welfare, wages, and work prospects of workers in Singapore.

Throughout his tenure at NTUC LHUB, he has played a pivotal role in advancing tripartism, fostering harmonious workplace relations, and promoting responsible employment practices. He brings valuable expertise in corporate governance and strategic investment to the NTUC LHUB board.

As its former Chairman, Brother Eugene led NTUC LHUB through a critical transition following the passing of its late CEO Kwek Kok Kwong in 2020. He was also instrumental in bolstering NTUC LHUB's training capabilities to support the Enhanced Training Support Package (ETSP) and SGUnited Skills (SGUS) programme. These efforts provided the workforce with stability and support during an unprecedented period.

Leveraging his extensive experience as a private markets investor, Brother Eugene was instrumental in the establishment of Tangram. As Chairman, he has been pivotal in forging Tangram's purpose, establishing sound governance principles and processes, bringing together its pioneering team, guiding Tangram on investment strategy, portfolio allocation, value creation and risk mitigation, and bolstering the long-term financial resilience of NTUC Enterprise.
