Lau Sze Hui has been a teacher with the Ministry of Education (MOE) since 2015.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, she was recognised for her agility in adapting the tools under MOE's Student Learning System (SLS) to conduct virtual learning for the students. For example, she successfully integrated and applied e-pedagogy and gamification to innovate her lessons.

In 2022 and 2023, Sister Sze Hui shared her expertise in teacher-led workshops and the Singapore Learning Designer's Community Virtual Meet on Differentiated Instruction and Gamification in SLS. At the cluster level, she participated in the Networking Learning Community and Learning Study led by a Master Teacher. She also harnessed SLS to organise a virtual learning session to Hong Kong and the application of Artificial Intelligence to promote student learning outcomes. She also shared her best practices at several other MOE-level events organised by the Education Technology Division. The division awarded her the Friends of SLS, Designer Badges and the Forerunner Badge.

At the school level, she leads the department's professional development initiative, Teacher Leader Consortium, School Instructional Mentoring Programme, the ICT enrichment programme, and the Literature Exploration & Appreciation Programme. Her Higher Chinese students clinched the first runner-up for the National Vlog Competition 2023 and Our Heart for Singapore National Education Award. For her contributions, Sister Sze Hui was conferred the Outstanding Contributor Award 2023 (Individual) and two Outstanding Contribution Awards (Group).

As a union member, she actively participates in Learning Journeys to improve the effectiveness of learning beyond the classroom. She attained her Master of Education during the COVID-19 pandemic and is now taking a Teacher Leader Programme.
