Applicants are reminded to send in documents complete with signature of declaration and supporting documents. Incomplete applications will not be approved for final submission to NTUC.

Kindly indicate a choice of 1-5 for the carnival dates for ballot purposes. All applications <u>must</u> reach UTES HQ before the stipulated closing dates above.
