Assisting Our Members

NTUC Care Fund (e-Vouchers)

The NTUC Care Fund (e-Vouchers) programme helps lower-income union members defray the cost of daily necessities and school essentials.

Over \$1,600,000 was electronically disbursed to close to 10,000 members and their families.

NTUC Care Fund (Special Assistance)

The NTUC Care Fund (Special Assistance) programme supports our lower-income members through the rising cost of living.

Over \$883,000 was disbursed to close to 7,600 members.



Health for Life Fund

The NTUC-U Care Fund contributed **\$100,000** to the Health for Life Fund to support the needs of seniors in their nursing homes and other elderly facilities.

Reaching Out to Our Community

U Care Caring • Sharing • Reaching Out (U Care CSR) Grant

Over **\$32,000** went towards supporting some **21 community service projects** that reached out to **close to 1,700 beneficiaries**.

Empowering Our Children and Youth

U Care Education Co-Funding Scheme

The U Care Education Co-Funding Scheme aims to motivate members' school-going children through bursary awards. In 2023, **\$287,237** was disbursed to **more than 3,000 children.**

CapitaLand-U Care Resilience and Enablement (CAP+Ure) Fund

The aim of CAP+Ure Fund is to provide assistance to middle-income union members impacted by sudden loss of income.

To date, over 356 members and 736 children have benefitted from this Fund.

Bright Horizons Fund

The NTUC-U Care Fund contributed **\$50,000** to the Bright Horizons Fund as it believes every child should have an equal start in life.
