

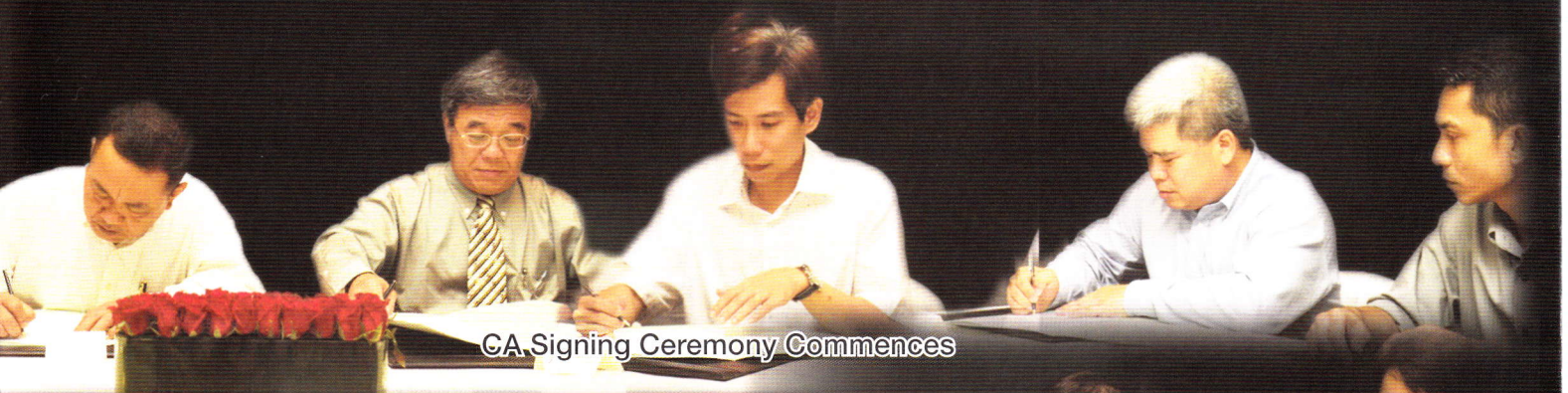

SRCEU LM2011 Commitments

SRCEU is committed to the Labour Movement's vision of LM 2011. Having set its key targets on achieving higher membership rate by year 2009. SRCEU even tried reaching out to members' family and management staff to join as union members in a bid to fulfill the membership target of Labour movement. In 2007 and 2008, SRCEU organized National Day Observance Ceremonies cum family event; reaching out to members' children to join as NEBO members, and spouse to join as union members. The exercises were very successful with considerable number of sign-ups.

Re-employed workers who are on Post Retirement Contract (PRC) basis would be able to join as Ordinary Members. SRCEU are able to represent such workers under limited representations. The immediate task for SRCEU is to encourage re-employed workers to continue their union membership so that their interests can be looked after. Workers who decided to retire can now enjoy a new chapter of their lives with U LIVE Community

so as to continue enjoying an active aging lifestyle. The unionization rate of re-employed contract workers is at 100 percent currently. Our Executive Committee member Brother Yeo Hock Hin is appointed as a committee member of Silver Collar Working Committee at NTUC. His task is to promote and reach out to Silver Collar workers, identify and deliver programmes in accordance to their needs.

Another focus of LM 2011 is Gold Collar workers which SRCEU has 70 percent membership for executives under limited representation. SRCEU has been actively reaching out to these members to understand their needs and how the SRCEU could improve their lives. We aim to achieve 100 percent membership eventually. SRCEU endeavors to work hand in hand with the Management to ensure that employees in SRC can fully enjoy the range of benefit offered to union members.

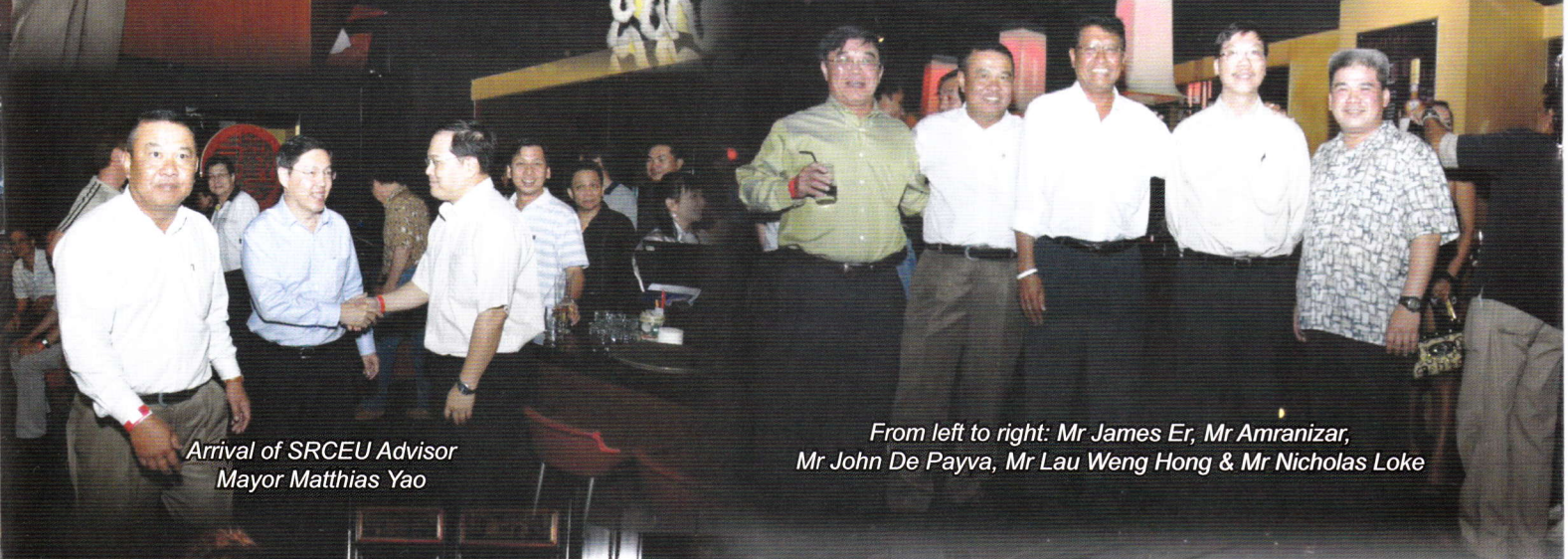

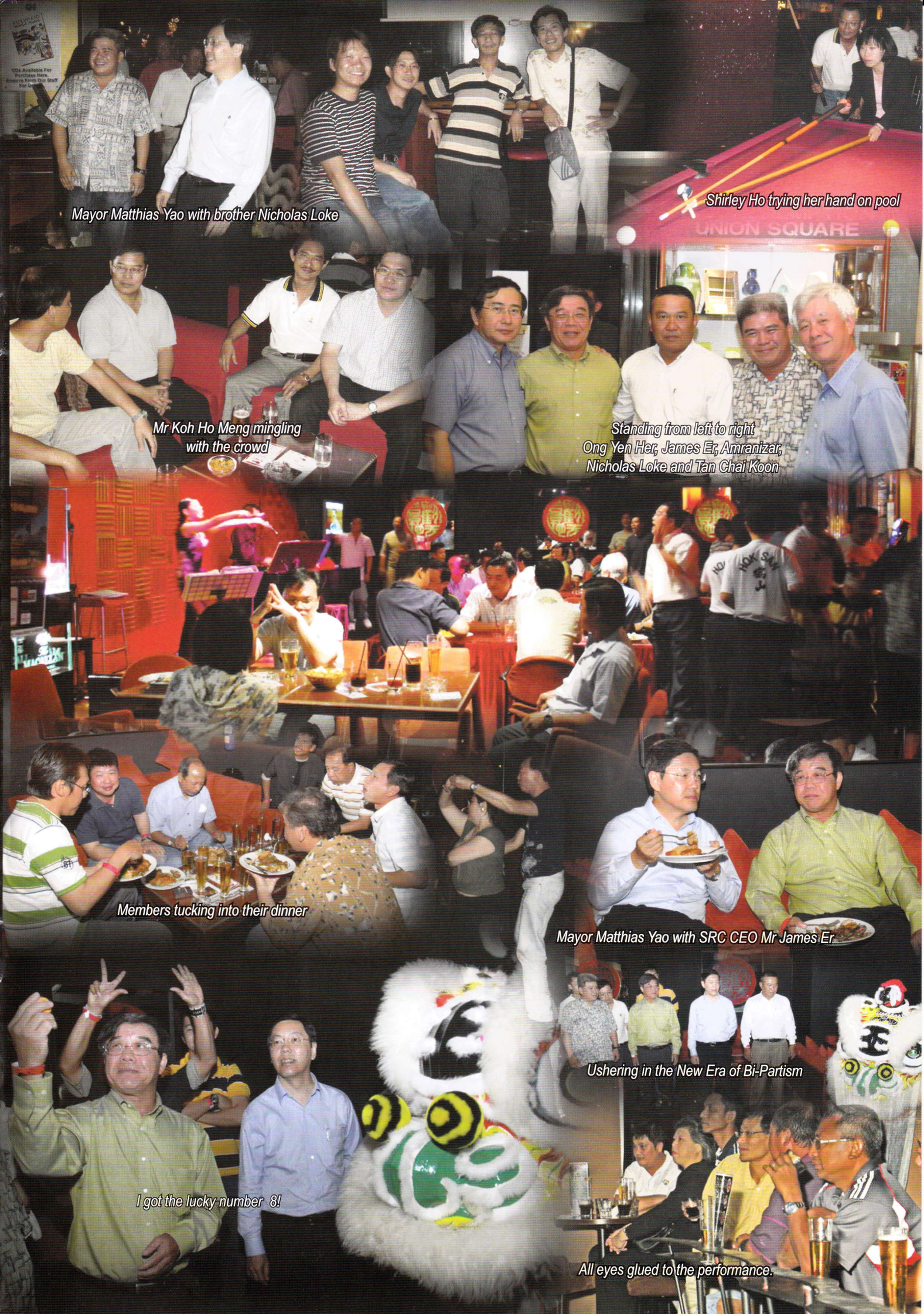

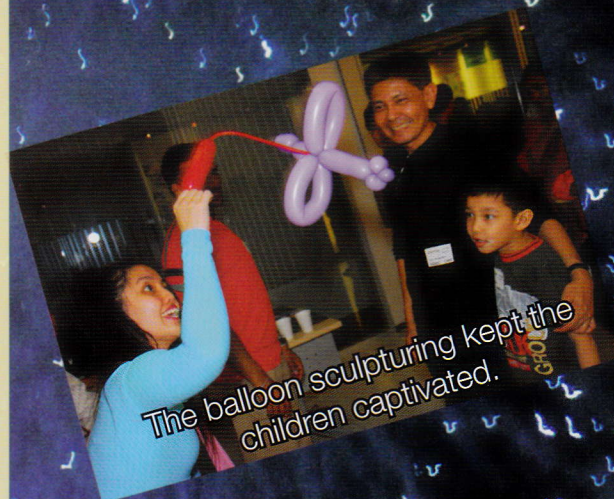
SRCEU National Day Observance 2008

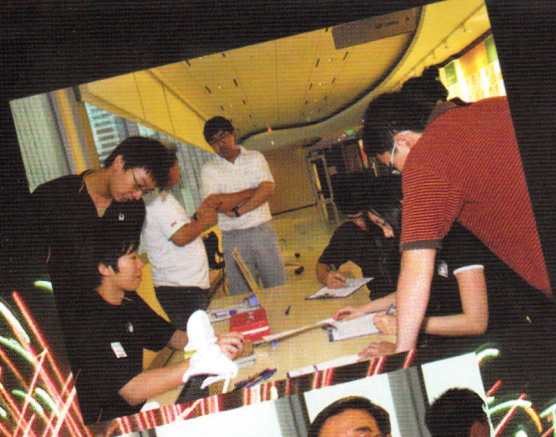

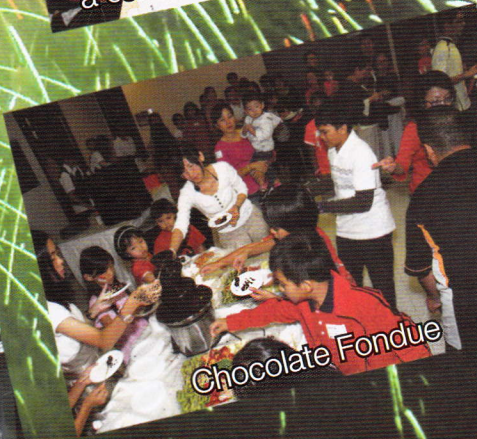

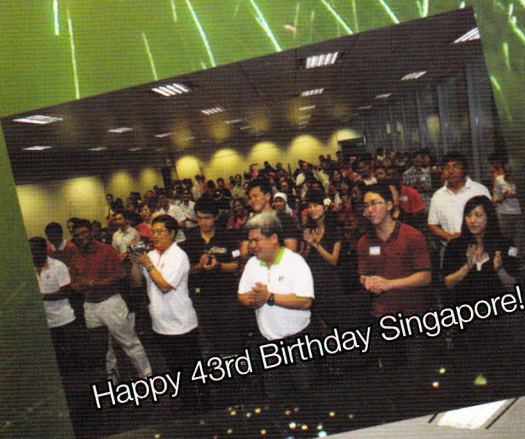
