Criteria

- a. Per Capita Income of the household of not more than **\$850** OR Total Monthly Gross Household Income of **\$3,600**.

b. Children of NTWU members who:

i) Must be studying in Government/Government-Aided/Independent Schools (Primary or Secondary) under MOE; Junior Colleges; Institute of Technical Education; Millennia Institute; Polytechnics or Autonomous Universities (NUS, NTU, SMU, SUTD, SIT and SUSS)

ii) Must achieve the following results:

Primary School (P1 to P4) Extended to P4 for 2022 due to no end of year exam in 2021	No Academic Criteria. As long as applicant meets prevailing Per Capita or Total Monthly Gross Household Income criteria.
Primary School (P5 to P6)	Pass in English, Mathematics and Mother Tongue
Secondary School & equivalent	Pass in English, Mathematics, Mother Tongue and 2 other subjects
Poly Year 1	Based on past year O-Level results (Pass at least 5 subjects based on L1R4) For Poly Y1 from ITE: based on CGPA 1.6 and above
Pre-U 1	Based on past year O-Level results (Pass at least 5 subjects based on L1R5)
Pre-U/Junior College & equivalent	Pass in General Paper or Knowledge & Inquiry and 3 other H1/H2 subjects
ITE	Grade Point Average of 1.6 and above Latest Cumulative GPA (CGPA)
Polytechnic	Grade Point Average of 1.6 and above Latest Cumulative GPA (CGPA)
University	Grade Point Average of 2.1 and above (SMU) Grade Point Average of 2.6 and above (All except SMU) Latest Cumulative GPA (CGPA)

Covid Exceptions – For Students who did not attempt their exam due to covid (Does not apply for P1-P4)	Proof of Covid infection during exam period. Use previous results slip instead.

11. An award will be given subject to the following considerations:

6. For Bursary Award:

- (a) All eligibility criteria are fully met
- (b) Validity of applications, i.e. all information are provided accurate

7. Scholarship Award

Children of NTWU members who:

- a) Study in Government/Government-Aided/Independent Schools (Primary or Secondary) under MOE; Junior Colleges; Institute of Technical Education; Millennia Institute; Polytechnics or Autonomous Universities (NUS, NTU, SMU, SUTD, SIT and SUSS)
- b) Possess outstanding academic results
- c) Possess other outstanding achievements beyond academia or school

8. Selection Criteria

- (a) Latest final year academic performance, with priority given to better performing students
- (b) Outstanding contributions beyond academia or school may be taken into consideration by the Selection Committee as it deems fit.
- (c) Other factors that the Selection Committee may from time to time deem fit.
- (d) Validity of applications, i.e. all information are provided accurately

9. Special Considerations for marginal cases

- Level of union involvement and participation
- Exceptional family circumstances
- i.e, Single Parent, a parent with an illness, financial hardship
- In the event where the number of eligible applications exceeds the allocated budget, the Union will rank the applications based on income and academic results, where applicable.
