Roger Lee Chin Tat has shown his support for NTUC's social membership programme, sponsoring membership fees for Singapore Institute of Materials Management's (SIMM) members who sign up for the programme. Brother Roger has pushed for membership sign-ups since the date of the signed collaboration agreement. Within three weeks, 30 per cent of SIMM's membership base has signed up for the programme. Additionally, Brother Roger has agreed to sponsor three months of union membership fees for SIMM students who enrolled in the Lean Six Sigma (Green Belt) Management Course and the Apply 5S Management Course, with the courses aiming to improve and upgrade workers' skills. Sponsoring the students' fees makes them eligible for NTUC's Union Training Assistance Programme funding, providing them with financial assistance to upgrade themselves.

In 2020, at the height of COVID-19, Brother Roger supported NTUC U Associates' effort to introduce job opportunities in the logistics and supply chain sector as a panellist in the first session of the panel discussion series. Apart from participating in NTUC U PME's U Associates leaders networking event, he represented SIMM at the event as part of the Land Connectivity Cluster innovation. He has also willingly volunteered his time and commitment to be a mentor in U PME's inaugural Executive Mentorship Programme. Brother Roger has shown vigour during events by NTUC, including the NTUC's National Delegates Conference 2023. Brother Roger actively showed interest and contributions when invited to participate in focus group discussions.
