1. What are the Awards?

Bursary Award	School-going children of our low-income members.
Scholarship Award	School-going children of members who are within the top of their school's level and course in terms of academic performance.
Special Award	School-going children of our members who are in eligible special education schools*. <i>*Refer to: https://www.moe.gov.sg/special-educational-needs/sped-schools</i>
STAR Award	School-going children of our members who have demonstrated excellence in non-academic activities.

2. What is the criteria and how much is the amount of the Awards?

We regret to inform you that we do not reveal the criteria and the award amount of the Awards.

3. What is the Pocket Money Fund?

UWEEI introduced the Pocket Money Fund in recent years as an additional support for school-going children of our low-income members. There is **no need to apply for the UWEEI Pocket Money Fund separately** if you have applied for any of the above Awards.

If your child has been awarded the Bursary Award, he/she **will also be automatically awarded** the UWEEI Pocket Money Fund. Similarly, if your child has been awarded the Scholarship/ Special/ STAR Award, and meets the income criteria for the UWEEI Pocket Money Fund, he/she will be automatically awarded the UWEEI Pocket Money Fund.

Unlike the other Awards, members whose children are studying overseas are welcomed to apply.

4. When will I know the outcome of my application?

If your application was successful, you will receive a **notification email by October 2024**. The Award Ceremony is scheduled for 9 November 2024. Due to the large volume of applications, only successful applicants will be informed.
